Tick items when you put your plan into effect

My triggers

These are the signs that will help you decide that it is time to leave early.

- ☐ Fire Danger Rating - Extreme or Catastrophic
- ☐ Safe to leave - time to exit safely
- ☐ Weather conditions - Hot and windy
- ☐ Bush fire less than 10klm from Middle Beach Rd
- ☐ Direction of wind will not drive fire to Middle Beach Rd

What I will take

- ☐ Medications
- ☐ Mobile phone/charger
- ☐ Personal treasures
- ☐ Caravan

My plan for pets and livestock

Pets are never left unattended at the park so all pets should be with residents

Where I will go

Depends on the direction the fire is travelling. Wasley Oval or Long Plains Oval. Two Wells and Virginia Oval are not designated as refuge. Text message to Janine on 0448898798 and Christopher on 0400225411

My plan if I have to stay and defend

I will only stay and defend on days of high fire danger if I am well prepared and my home is properly constructed and prepared to the highest level.

Tick items when you put your plan into effect

Before the fire arrives

Outside your home

- ☐ Patrol for spot fires and extinguish
- ☐ Plug drains and fill gutters with water
- ☐ wet down buildings facing the direction of the fire
- ☐ Listen to radio
- ☐ check on your "buddies" as indicated on appendix A
- ☐ hitch up caravan
- ☐ clear area around caravan if you cannot hitch up
- ☐ ensure Janine or Christopher know the direction you are heading before you leave

Inside your home

- ☐ Dress in protective clothing
- ☐ Place wet towels in any crevices such as gaps under doors etc
- ☐ Shut all doors and windows
- ☐ Take curtains down and push furniture away from windows

When the fire arrives

- ☐ Drink plenty of water
- ☐ Patrol inside for spot fires and extinguish
- ☐ Reassure family and pets
- ☐ If you haven't left and fire is close Assemble at Emergency Evacuation point
- ☐ do not stay in caravan or room
- ☐ assemble in dining room or shop after fire warden assess the direction of fire

After the fire passes

- ☐ Continue drinking plenty of water
- ☐ Continue to patrol for 48 hours
- ☐ Let family and neighbours know we're okay
- ☐ Patrol for spot fires and extinguish
- ☐ Return outside when safe to do so
